



ProQuest Psychology Journals - abstracts and indexing for more than 640 titles, with over 540 titles available in full text, some dating back to 1971. Also includes 4,000 full text dissertations representing a range of psychology disciplines for 2000 through 2005.

- [66 references](#) – go to the list of references cited by this article – links to abstracts and full text where available will come up – available for most records even without full text.
